

# FALL 2015 FRESHMAN ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS AT TEMPLE UNIVERSITY



- 70 percent of first-year students receive need-based financial aid.
- 42 percent of first-year students receive an academic scholarship.

Temple University *does not require* a separate application for an academic scholarship.

Academic scholarships are limited to four consecutive years and are renewed annually provided you maintain at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.

Applicants who choose the Temple Option—a new way to apply to Temple without standardized test scores—are still eligible for scholarships and the Honors Program. We recommend that applicants who have scored an 1150 on the SAT (on a 1600-point scale) or a 25 on the ACT submit their scores as a part of their application. \*President's and Provost's Scholars are *automatically admitted* to the Honors Program. Dean's Scholars and Founder's Scholarship recipients, if admitted to the Honors Program, will receive a one-summer, \$4,000 education enhancement stipend.

\*\*Only academic courses are considered (English, social studies, mathematics, sciences and languages). The highest result of two methods is used to obtain an SAT score on the 1600-point scale; in both methods, the highest submitted SAT scores are used:

- Critical Reading + Math, or
- the average of Critical Reading + Writing added to Math

**The deadline to appeal for additional scholarship monies based on new testing information is January 15.**
