## <u>Instructions for submitting Predicted/Final International Qualifications</u>

To be considered for admission and scholarship, you are able to submit predicted/final results using any of the approved international qualifications. Your school can submit your predicted results on a transcript, in a letter of recommendation, as an additional document in the Common Application or as another official communication.

Predicted/estimated results should take into consideration your expected academic progress through to graduation. For guidance on submitting predicted results, please feel free to reach out to the international admissions office.

Attention Students and Counselors: Predicted results are an estimate of a student's final performance on a specific international qualification (exam or set of exams). Temple realizes that final results may not always match predicted results. We ask only that predictions reflect a student's current academic progress and an estimate of final performance.

All Temple applicants, regardless of academic testing submitted, are expected to continue until graduation at the same rate of progress demonstrated at the time of application. However, schools will not be held responsible for discrepancies between predictions and final results. If after the time of application, there is any concern regarding a student's ability to achieve their predicted result, please contact the international admissions office.
