What to Bring

Personal Items

- Towels/washcloths
- Laundry bag or hamper
- Hangers
- Shower caddy
- Contact lens supplies and/or glasses
- Tissues
- Toiletries
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Hand Sanitizer
- Water Bottle
- Sunglasses
- First-aid supplies (band-aids, etc.)
- Medications/prescriptions if applicable

Clothing

- Casual outfits
- Pajamas
- Sweater or jacket
- Rain gear (including umbrella)
- Gym/fitness clothes
- Socks
- Underwear
- Closed-toe shoes
- Sandals/flip flops (including a pair to wear in the shower)
- Bathrobe for walking to/from the bathroom
- Business casual clothing and shoes for field trips

For Classes and Studying

- Book bag
- Notebooks, pens, folders, highlighters
- Art supplies (Tyler only; lists provided for each class)
- Textbooks (Summer Scholars only; book list provided)

ID and Personal Info

- Health insurance cards
- Photo ID

Appliances (Approved, OPTIONAL)

- Audio equipment w/ headphones
- Computer (laptop)
- Device chargers (phone, tablet, laptop etc.)
- Curling iron or hair straightener (auto shut-off)
- Surge Protector

Other

- Quarters for washer & dryer (You may also use your Diamond Dollars.)
- Spending money, if desired
- Leisure/ hobby related items
- Small trash can for your room
- Plates and eating utensils
- Non-perishable snacks and secure storage for snacks
- Light cleaning supplies (Clorox wipes)

NOT RECOMMENDED

- Televisions
- Video game systems

DO NOT BRING

- Microwaves or mini fridges
- Alcohol, drugs, tobacco/nicotine products (including vapes)
- Weapons of any kind, including mace or pepper spray
- Appliances exceeding 50W (air conditioners, space heaters, music amplifiers, etc.)
- Anything that could start a fire including but not limited to candles, incense, aromatherapy oil burners, toasters, convection ovens, hot plates, etc.
- Pets (other than certified service dog)
- Materials/mechanisms for lofting/raising beds
- Network equipment (wireless access points, routers, etc.)
- 3M strips or anything that could remove paint from walls
